2. The bidder shall deposit the cost of bid document of the amount specified for the work in **Col.4** of table above in shape Money Receipt of Cash deposit.
3. The successful bidder shall deposit the Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of the amount specified for the work in **Col.5** of table above in shape Money Receipt of Cash deposit /B.D./ F.D. duly pledged in favour of Executive Officer, Barbil Municipality should be furnished after finalization of tender process.
4. The tenderer has to produce valid documents at the time of purchase of tender paper on demand for verification.
5. Furnishing of photo copies of valid registration of Contractor license, GST and PAN card along with the tender papers is mandatory, otherwise the tender is liable for rejection.
6. Contractors are required to write only the name of work for which tendered & the Officer to whom submitted (Name of the contractor/ tenderer should not be mentioned on the cover).
7. The tenders will be received in the office of the undersigned in specified tender box.
8. The authority reserves the right to cancel any or all tenders without assigning any reason thereof.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA/ CONDITION

1. The tenderers should have successfully completed similar type of work not less than 50% of the tender amount in any one of the past 3 (three) years and necessary documents in support of the above shall be submitted.
2. The tenderer shall consist of tender document with the rates amounts etc only.
3. No tender documents will be sold to the intending tenderer beyond the date and time of sale mentioned in the tender notice.
4. No tenderers will be permitted to furnish their tender in their own manuscript papers. No letter should accompany the tender.
5. The work is to be completed in all respect within schedule time. Tenderer whose tender is accepted must submit a programme of work immediately after issue of the work order for the approval of Engg-in-charge. Further the tenderer must submit a list of Tools and Plants for execution of the works. If the tenderer shall carry the above materials on hire charges basis, he must submit the affidavit of the owner of the machineries with his support otherwise the department reserve the right to reject his tender.
6. The rates should be written both in words and figures and in decimal coinage and the units in words. In case of discrepancy in rates between words and figures the rates in words will prevail. The tenderer should also show the total of each item and grand total of the whole tender. The tender shall be written, legibly, and free from erasing, over writing, corrections. Every page of the tender paper must be signed by the tenderer, failing which the tender will be rejected.
7. The tenderers shall carefully study the specifications applicable to a contract and all the documents will form a part of the agreement to be entered into by the accepted tenderer and detailed specifications and other relevant specifications in estimate, which are available. Complaint at a future date that specifications have not been seen cannot be entertained.
8. Every tenderer is expected before quoting his rate to inspect the proposed site, quarries and satisfy himself about the rates, royalty & other taxes and quality and availability of the materials. In every case, materials must comply with the relevant specifications. Complaint at a future date that rates and availability of materials have been misjudged cannot be entertained.
9. It must be definitely understood that this office does not accept any responsibility for the correctness and completeness of the trial borings shown in the cross section.
10. Each tenderer must pay an earnest money of 1% of the estimated cost in shape of cash/Account Payee Bank Draft in favour of Executive Officer, Barbil Municipality along with the tender. Tender paper not accompanied with M.R/B.D against E.M.D. as specified above will be summarily rejected.
11. The tender should be accompanied with photocopies of (i) Valid up to date Pan card (ii) Contractor license copy, failing which the tender is liable for rejection. The original certificate may be produced before the Executive Officer at the time of the scrutiny.
12. Letter etc found in the tender box raising or lowering the rates or dealing with the tender and regarding adjustment of EMD and any other matter will not be considered.
13. No payment will be made for layout, bench mark level, pillars, profiles and benching and leveling the ground required, which has to be carried out by the contractor at his own cost. The rate to be quoted should be for furnished items of works inclusive of carriage of all materials and all incidental items of work inclusive of carriage of all material and all incidental items of work.
14. After the work is finished all surplus materials should be removed from the site of work, preliminary works such as mixing platform etc. should be dismantled and all materials removed from the sites and premises left neat and this should be inclusive in the rates.
15. It should be understood clearly that no claim whatsoever will be entertained in regards to extra item of the work or extra quantity of the items besides estimated amount. A written order must be obtained from the responsible officer of Municipality before the extra items of works or extra item quantity of any item of work is taken up and rate settled for extra item of work and necessary supplement agreement for the same is drawn up where ever necessary.
16. (a) Rent, royalties, cess and other charges of materials, octroi and all other taxes including sales tax, ferry tolls, conveyance charges and other cost on account of land and buildings including temporary building required by the tenderer for collection of materials storage, housing of staff or other purpose of the work are to be borne by the contractors at his own cost. No rent will be payable to Govt. for temporary occupation of land owned by Govt. at the site of the work for bonafied use of the land for work.
(b) Royalty will be recovered from each bill as notified by Govt. from time to time unless for

mineral materials.

- (c) Labour camps or huts necessary to a suitable scale including scale including conveyance and sanitary arrangements therein to the satisfaction of the local health authorities.
 - (d) Suitable water supply including pipe water supply where available for the staff labour as well as for the works should be provided by the contractor at his own cost.
 - (e) Fees and dues levied by Municipal, canal or water supply authorities.
 - (f) Suitable equipments and wearing apparatus for the labourer engaged in risky operations.
 - (g) Suitable fencing, barriers, signals including paraffin's and electric signals where necessary at work and approaches in order to protect the public and employees from accident.
 - (h) Compensation including cost of any suit for injury to persons or property due to neglect of any precautions also sum which may become payable due to operation of the workmen compensation act.
 - (i) The contractor has to arrange adequate lighting arrangements for the works wherever necessary at his own cost.
17. No relation certificate:-
The tenderer should not be related to any officer/ Councillor of Barbil Municipality. If the fact subsequently proved to be false, the contract will be rescinded. The earnest money and the total security will be forfeited and he shall be liable to make good to the loss or damages resulting from such cancellation.
18. The Deptt. will have the right to inspect for the work and can reject partly or fully such works if found defective in their opinion. The tenderer has all responsibility to make the work convenient so as to meet the specification made in the estimate.
19. Bitumen/Concrete should be machine mixed unless and other wise ordered in writing by the Executive Officer. The contractor should arrange his own Tool and plants like mixer, pumps, etc for this purpose at his own cost and departmental machinery if available only may be utilized on payment of necessary hire charges.
20. Bitumen shall be used by packets and weight of one Bitumen packet being taken as per the provision made by the OSIC, Keonjhar.
21. The contractor will be responsible for loss or damaged of any departmental materials during transit in the execution of work due to reasons what so ever and the cost of such materials will be recovered from the bills at stock issue rates or market rates whichever is higher.
22. If the contractor removes any Govt. materials supplied to him from the site of the work with a view to dispose the same dishonestly, he shall be in addition to any other liability civil or criminal arising out of his contract be liable to pay a penalty equivalent to five times the price of the materials according to the rate stipulated in the recovery schedule or issued rate of the Municipality penalty so imposed shall be recovered at any time from any sum or from his security deposit .
23. The Deptt. will have the right to supply at any time in the interest of the work any departmental materials to be used in the work and the contractor used such materials without any controversy on that account. The rates of the materials will be at the stock issue rate or current schedule of rates whichever is higher.
24. All materials which are to be supplied from Municipality will be as per the availability of stock and the contractor will have to bear the charges of conveyance from the office store.
25. The contractor should be arranging the necessary tools and plants at his own cost.
26. It must be clearly understood that under no circumstances any interest is chargeable for the dues or additional dues if any payable for the work executed of final bill pending disposal due to any reason thereof.
27. No extra payment will be made for removing, spreading, and consolidating salvaged materials.
28. In the event of any particular items of the work which the contractor has quoted rate, which are grossly below the corresponding estimated rates or (CSR) for the particular item , the difference between the amount according to the estimated cost or (CSR) rate and the grossly under quoted rate for quantity of work to be executed by the contractor shall be kept withheld from the payment of the contractor until the work completed in all respect by the to the full satisfaction of the Engg-in-charge.
29. The department have the right to inspect all the scaffolding, centering, shuttering work and can reject partly or fully if found defective their opinion.
30. If there is any damage to the work due to natural calamities like flood or cyclone or any other cause during the course of execution of work or up to 6 months after completion of work or if any imperfection becomes apparent to the work within 6months from the date of final; certificate of completion of work the contractor shall make good of all such damages at his own cost with no extra

cost to the department. No claims, whatsoever, in this regards will be entertained.

31. Standard co-efficient for linear measurement will be adopted while calculating consumption of materials and no claim whatsoever regarding difference of materials will be entertained. The rates quoted shall be inclusive of any eventually of difference for co-efficient for linear measurement.
32. As per Works Department office memorandum No.5288/W dated.4.5.2016 Amendment to Para-3.5.5(V) of Note-II of OPWD Code, Vol-I by modification, Additional performance security shall be deposited by the bidder when the bid amount is less than the estimated cost put to tender. In such an event, the bidders who have quoted less bid price/ rates than the estimated cost put to tender shall have to furnish the exact amount of differential cost i.e. estimated cost put to tender minus the quoted amount as Additional Performance Security in shape of Demand Draft/ Term Deposit Receipt pledged in favour of the Executive Officer, Barbil Municipality in the sealed envelope along with the price bid at the time of submission of bid. The bids of technically qualified bidders will be opened for evaluation of the price bid. In case of the bidders quoting less bid price/ rate than the estimated cost put to tender and have not furnished the exact amount of differential cost (i.e. estimated cost put to tender minus the quoted amount) as Additional Performance Security in shape of Demand Draft/ Term Deposit Receipt, their price bid will not be taken in to consideration for evaluation even if they have qualified in the technical bid evaluation.
33. No advance will be paid to the contractor during the course of execution of the work. If the department felt necessary, the running bill will be paid to the contractor after deduction of 10% of the pending completion of the work. Further, the contractor failed to complete the work in time penalty must be imposed against the contractor @ 1% of the estimated cost per month or as desired by the Department.
34. All materials to be used for mortar/mixture should be measured is standard measurement box.
35. Specimen of concrete to be used for structural work should be taken is cube mould as per IS specification for testing. The testing of the cubes and other materials should be done in Govt. laboratory or laboratories approved by Govt. The cost for testing and collecting of samples for the purpose should be payable by the contractor and the test report should be furnished to the Executive Officer.
